Analyzing and assess the information from key sources, along with primary and secondary data before compile it to a general insight of COVID-19 control in Bali.

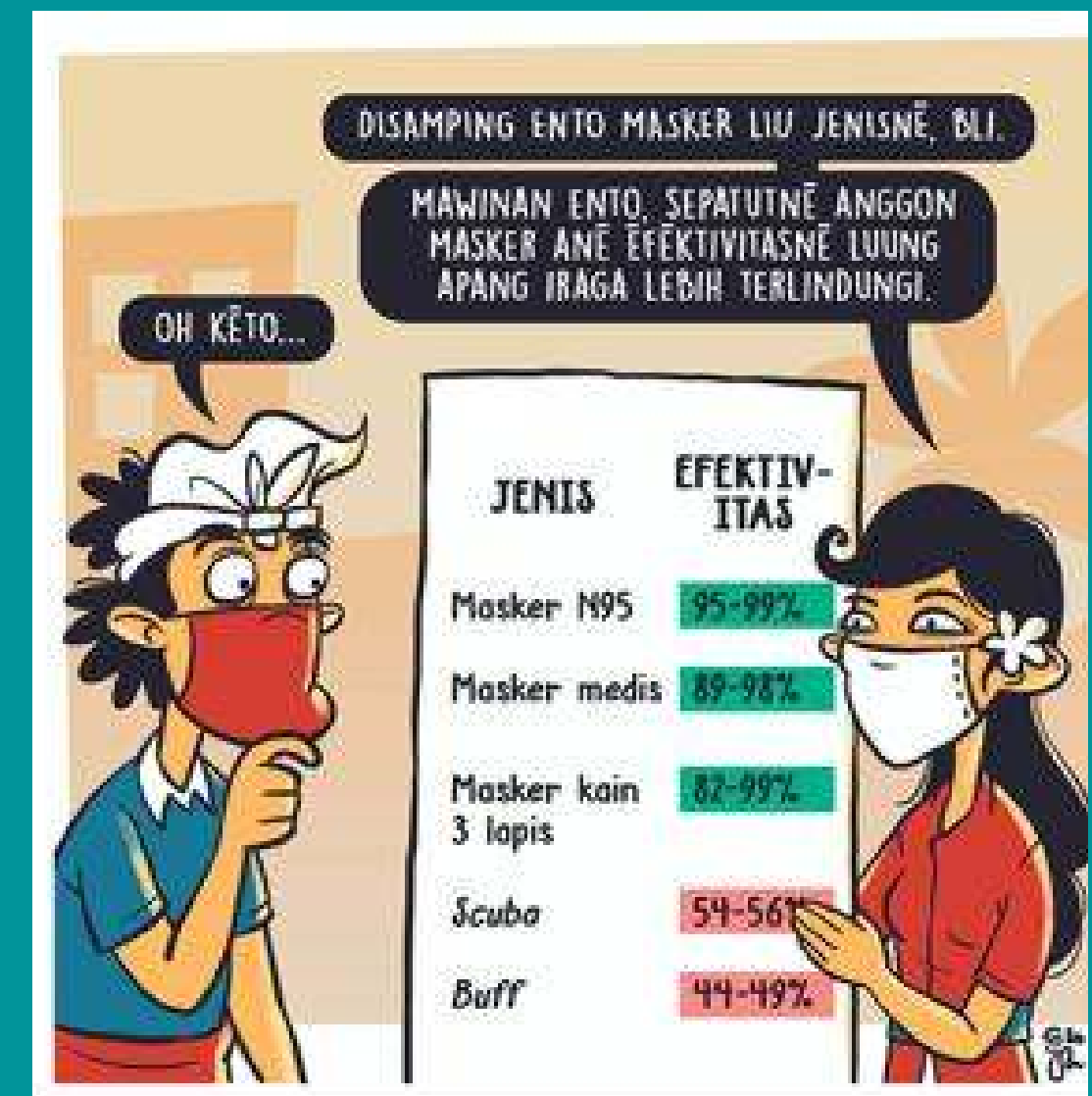
Build Recommendation

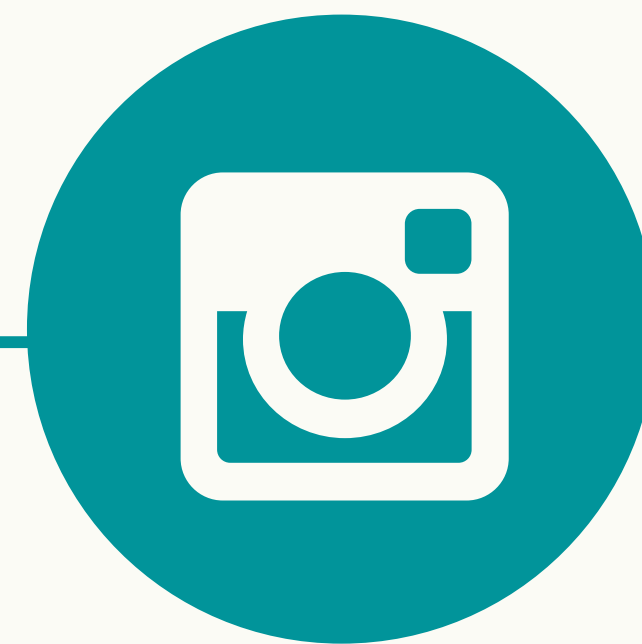
